

#### DEFINITION

Visual identity is how a business represents themselves through the use of color, logos, typefaces, and names.

#### **OUR POLICY**

We want the citizens of Trenton to look at the T-RECS logo and know that it represents the T-RECS unit. We want to adapt the posters and text for both adults and children, while maintaining the integrity of the image without modifications, and capturing the eye of someone passing by.

#### WHAT IS T-RECS ROAR?

T-RECS is the Trenton Recreation Unit that comes to West Trenton to provide the community with games, activities, free wifi, and assorted medical services.

ROAR is our acronym for "Recreational Opportunities for Advising Residents" in the Trenton community. We use the application Textit.in to allow residents to sign up for alerts where we can send text messages to advertise where the T-RECS unit is located on a particular day.

# Official Logo



Because the recreational unit is called a T-RECS (Trenton Recreation Unit), we have adapted a logo that includes a T-Rex to help children recognize the unit at a glance. It is important to maintain this logo without altercation to maintain the integrity of the image.

For comparison, we have included three different scales for the logo. The logo should not be reduced after 1 inch to maintain clarity.






